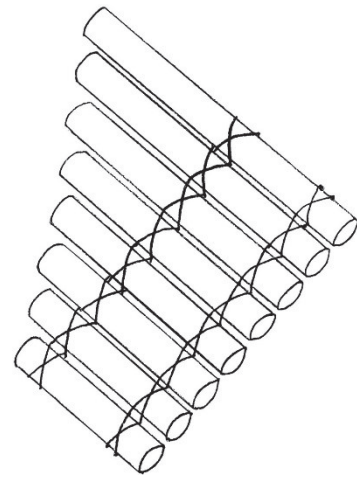


BUILD YOUR OWN PAN FLUTE

Materials:

Straws (8)
Ruler
Tape
Scissors
Stickers or Markers



Instructions:

STEP 1:

Line up the eight straws, and mark the measurements on the straws with a marker before cutting. The first straw will not be cut, and does not need any marking. The second straw should be measured 2 cm shorter (off the top) than the first straw. The third straw should be marked 2 cm shorter than the second straw. Continue until each straw is 2 cm shorter than the straw before it.

STEP 2:

Cut the straws to the lengths you have measured. Line up the straws from tallest to shortest.

STEP 3:

Using masking tape, tape all the straws together. Make sure that the straws are lying flat while you are taping, and that tape goes around the end where there is no difference in length (bottom).

STEP 4:

Decorate your pan flute! Use stickers, markers, or any other craft supplies to make your pan flute unique.

STEP 5:

Play away! To play your pan flute, you will want to blow evenly into the straws at the bottom end, and leave a little space between your mouth and the pan flute. You want to blow into it without your lips touching the straws.
